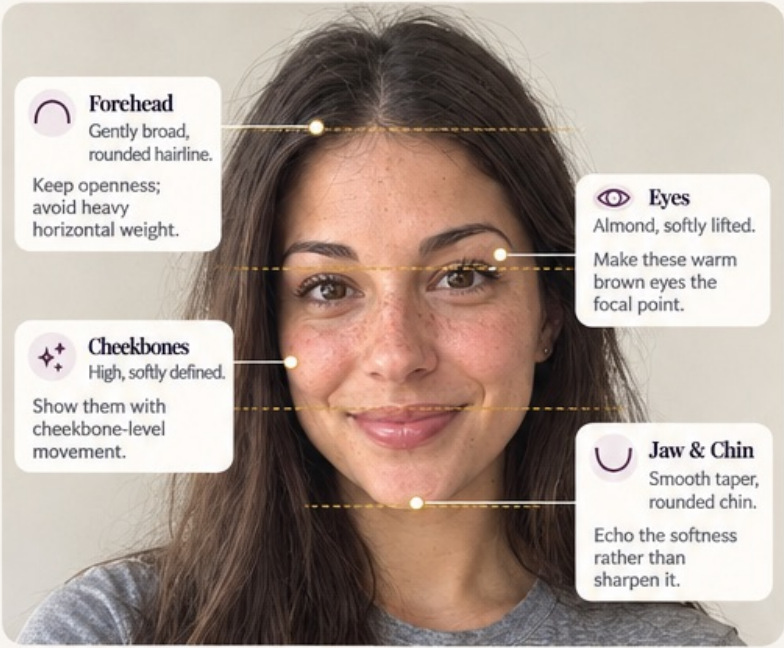

What It Means For Your Styling

Use controlled softness to spotlight expressive eyes and balanced cheekbones.



Hair & Framing

Movement should begin around the cheekbones, not the chin.

- Center or soft off-center part.
